Benefit Flyers, Brochures, and More

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

Preparing for End of PHE

As you may know, the federal government and State of Washington are preparing to exit the Public Health Emergency (PHE), so CHPW is working to ensure that you and our members who are losing Medicaid eligibility have all the information needed to seamlessly transition to a qualified health plan or Medicare. We want to remind you that CHPW offers a robust suite of <u>Medicare Advantage</u> plan options. We also support our parent organization, Community Health Network of Washington (CHNW), in offering a competitive individual and family insurance product – <u>Cascade</u> <u>Select.</u> (In 2022, we offer the lowest-cost Silver Cascade Select plan in 13 of 18 counties we're in.)

Over-the-Counter COVID-19 Test Coverage

The process for obtaining free at-home COVID-19 antigen tests for our members is simple and the same no matter what CHPW plan someone has! Apple Health members can receive up to 12 individual tests per month, and Medicare Advantage and Cascade Select members can receive up to 8 individual tests per month. These are in addition to the free test kits you can order from the federal and state governments. Visit our
