Getting vaccinated for COVID-19 is the best way to keep you and your loved ones safe.



Why should I get vaccinated?

Vaccination prevents you from getting COVID-19. The sooner more people are vaccinated, the sooner we can get back to the lives we knew, which includes socializing, going to school and work.

Are all COVID-19 vaccines safe and effective?

Yes. All COVID vaccines passed the same rigorous testing required for every vaccine. Over 75,000 patients were involved in vaccine trials and monitored for months before vaccines were approved. You CANNOT get COVID-19 from a vaccine.

Are there any side effects?

Some patients report minor side effects such as injection site soreness and headaches. You may experience flu-like symptoms which show the vaccine is working. Serious side effects are rare and every patient is monitored after vaccination to ensure their safety.

Will my immigration status be collected when getting a vaccine?

No. You do not need to share any sensitive personal information to get vaccinated. Getting a vaccine from a community health center is the same as getting a flu shot or regular check up from a clinic you trust.
