









IMC Mental Health EBP Reporting for Behavioral Health Providers

What are Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) codes?

EBP codes are specially designated identifiers on a claim or encounter that are used to report specific research- or evidence-based practices for children's public mental health care provided by licensed or certified mental health providers to **children and youth under 18** in Washington State. It is a requirement in the Integrated Managed Care (IMC) regions of the state that encounter submissions from managed care organizations (MCOs) contain the appropriate EBP code when applicable.

How should I document EBPs?

Mental health providers are able to report eligible EBPs after (1) receiving an interactive training by an approved training entity, and (2) documenting their use of EBPs in treatment plans and progress notes. Guidance on how to correctly document the use of EBPs is outlined in the Reporting Guide for Evidence-based Practices (updated annually).

How are these codes reported?

The EBP number must be reported as a nine-digit number beginning with '860'. The next three digits must represent the appropriate EBP code as outlined in the Reporting Guide for Evidence-based Practices. The last three digits must be reported as '000'.

Example: 860XXX000 with XXX representing the three-digit EBP code.

Report one EBP code per encounter in the 2300 REF02 Prior Authorization field of the 837 data file submission.

- The REF01 field contains the 'G1' qualifier (i.e., prior authorization).
- The REF02 field should contain the nine-digit EBP code.

IMC Mental Health EBP Reporting for Physical Health Providers

There is also an HCA Mental Health guide for physical health providers with a separate set of codes.

Evidence-based medicine, evidence-based practice, research-based practice, and evidence-based health care (collectively "EBPs") include programs such as cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and the Positive Parenting Program (Triple P). Agencies are required by law to collect data on EBPs in Washington State. Physical health providers who deliver these services to **clients under age 21** should include the appropriate EPA number from the following table when billing for EBP.
